About Edgefield

Built as the county poor farm in 1911 at the entrance to the Columbia River Gorge and later used as an old folks' home, Edgefield was marked for demolition until the McMenamin brothers renovated the property in the mid-1990s. Today, this destination resort and national historic landmark offers over 100 guestrooms, along with indoor and outdoor meeting and event spaces that can accommodate smaller groups of 20 or larger groups up to 225 and include Wi-Fi and onsite catering. Or perhaps organize a golf tournament on one of our two par-3 courses. After your event, visit the fine-dining Black Rabbit Restaurant, the casual Power Station Pub, our many small bars, gardens, distillery, winery and tasting room, Ruby's Spa and soaking pool, movie theater and more.
